Queen, Defender of the Faith, &c. To all to whom these Presents shall come. Greeting:

KNOW YE. That We, of Our special grace, certain knowledge, and mere motion, have given and granted, and We do, by these Presents, for Us, Our Heirs and Successors, give and grant unto

John Voutour his heirs and assigns a tract of land situate in the parish of Carleton in the County Kent in our province of New Brunswick and bounded as follows to wit: - Beginning at the southeasterly angle of lot number eighty nine on the northerly bank or shore of Kouchibouguac River thence north thru degrees and thirty minutes east fifty six chains to a fir tree standing on the southern side of a carved road thence along the same south eighty six degrees and thirty minutes east eighteen chains to a stake thence south thru degrees and thirty minutes west fifty nine chains to a birch tree standing on the northerly bank or shore of the above mentioned river and thence following the various courses thereof up Stream in a westerly direction to the place of beginning containing one hundred acres more or less and distinguished as lot number eight eight on the northerly bank or shore of Kouchibouguac River Readville

and also particularly described and marked on the Plot or Plan of Survey hereunto annexed; together with all profits, commodities, hereditaments, and appurtenances whatsoever thereunto belonging, or in any wise appertaining; except and reserved, nevertheless, out of this present Grant, to Us, Our Heirs and Successors, all Coals, and also all Gold and Silver, and other Mines and Minerals: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said *tract* of Land, and all and singular the Premises hereby granted, with their appurtenances, (except before excepted), unto the said *John Voutour his heirs and assigns* FOR EVER. PROVIDED always, and this present Grant is upon condition, that the same Grant be registered in the Secretary's Office of Our said Province of New Brunswick, to which Registry shall be attached a duplicate of the Plan hereunto annexed.

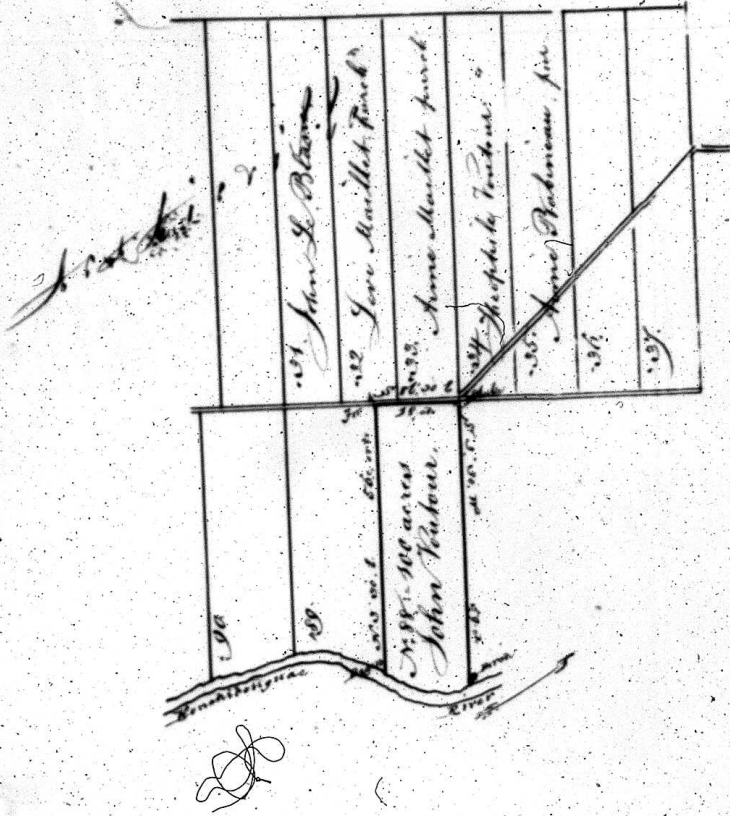
