KNOW YE. That We, of Our special grace, certain knowledge, and mere motion, have given and

granted, and We do, by these Presents, for Us, Our Heirs and Successors, give and grant unto

William Graham his heirs and assigns a tract of Land situated in the parish of Carlton in
the County of Kent in New Brunswick bounded and bounded on the east

beginning at a tree standing at the south-

easterly angle of the lot purchased by Antonio
D'Vault on the northwesterly bank or Shore of Kouchibouguac
or great river Alascerville, three north
three degrees and thirty minutes east Sixty chains
thence South eighty six degrees and thirty minutes-
east Sixteen chains thence South three degrees
and thirty minutes west Sixty chains to a fir
tree standing on the northwesterly bank or Shore
of Kouchibouguac River and thence following
the various courses thereof up Stream in a
westerly direction to the place of beginning
Containing Thirty six acres more or less

and also particularly described and marked on the Plot or Plan of Survey hereunto annexed; together with all profits,
commodities, hereditaments, and appurtenances whatsoever thereunto belonging, or in any wise appertaining; except
