Victoria, by the Grace of God, of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland,
QUEEN, Defender of the Faith, &c. To all to whom these Presents shall come. Greeting:

KNOW YE, That We, of Our special grace, certain knowledge, and mere motion, have given and granted, and We do, by these Presents, for Us, Our Heirs and Successors, give and grant unto

Calisto Daigle his heirs and assigns
a tract of land situate in the Parish of
Barlinton in the County of Kent in our
Province of New Brunswick and bounded
as follows to wit, Beginning at a spruce
tree standing at the south easterly angle of
lot number twenty two in Acadieville
thence south eighty six degrees and
thirty minutes east twelve chains and
fifty links by spruce tree thence north three
degrees and thirty minutes east eighty chains
thence north eighty six degrees and thirty
minutes west twelve chains and fifty links
and thence south three degrees and thirty
minutes west eighty chains to the place of
beginning containing one hundred acres
more or less and distinguished as lot number
twenty three in Acadieville

and also particularly described and marked on the Plot or Plan of Survey hereunto annexed; together with all profits, commodities, hereditaments, and appurtenances whatsoever thereunto belonging, or in any wise appertaining; except and reserved, nevertheless, out of this present Grant, to Us, Our Heirs and Successors, all Coals, and also all Gold and Silver, and other Mines and Minerals: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract of Land, and all and singular the Premises hereby granted, with their appurtenances, (except before excepted), unto the said Calisto Daigle his heirs and assigns FOR EVER.

PROVIDED always, and this present Grant is upon condition, that the same Grant be registered in the Secretary's Office of Our said Province of New Brunswick, to which Registry shall be attached a duplicate of the Plan hereunto annexed.
