QUEEN, Defender of the Faith, &c. To all to whom these Presents shall come. Greeting:

KNOW YE. That We, of Our special grace, certain knowledge, and mere motion, have given and granted, and We do, by these Presents, for Us, Our Heirs and Successors; give and grant unto

John & Vautour his heirs and assigns
a tract of land situate in the Parish of
Parlinton in the County of Kent in our Province
of New Brunswick and bounded as follows
to wit, Beginning at a fir tree standing at
the southeasterly angle of lot number forty
six in Acaderville three north thirty degrees
and thirty minutes east sixty six Chains and
eighty links thence south eighty six degrees and
thirty minutes east fifteen Chains thence south
thirty degrees and thirty minutes west sixty
six Chains and eighty links to a stump and
thence north eighty six degrees and thirty
minutes west fifteen Chains to the place of
beginning Containing One Hundred acres
more or less and distinguished as lot
number forty seven in Acaderville

and also particularly described and marked on the Plot or Plan of Survey hereunto annexed; together with all profits, commodities, hereditaments, and appurtenances whatsoever thereunto belonging, or in any wise appertaining; except and reserved, nevertheless, out of this present Grant, to Us, Our Heirs and Successors, all Coals, and also all Gold and Silver, and other Mines and Minerals, TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract of Land, and all and singular the Premises hereby granted with their appurtenances, (except before excepted), unto the said

John & Vautour his heirs and assigns FOR EVER.
