# NEW BRUNSWICK.

Victoria, by the Grace of GOD, of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland,

QUEEN, Defender of the Faith, &c. To all to whom these Presents shall come; Greeting:

KNOW YE, That We, of our Our special grace, certain knowledge, and mere motion, have given and granted, and We do, by these Presents, for Us, Our Heirs and Successors, give and grant unto

Basil Babineau his Heirs and Assigns,

a Tract of Land situate in the Parish of Acadieville

in the County of Kent

of New Brunswick, and bounded as follows, to-wit:—

Beginning at the south westerly angle of lot B purchased by Sylvester Masrall in Acadieville thence South eighty six degrees and thirty minutes east fifty seven chains thence south three degrees and thirty minutes west sixteen chains and seventy links thence north eighty six degrees and thirty minutes west fifty seven chains to a stake and thence north three degrees and thirty minutes east sixteen chains and seventy links to the place of beginning Containing Sixty five acres more or less and distinguished as lot A in Acadieville

and also particularly described or marked on the Plot or Plan of Survey hereunto annexed; together with all profits, commodities, hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever thereunto belonging, or in any wise appertaining; except and reserved, nevertheless, out of this present Grant, to Us, Our Heirs and Successors, all Coals, and also all Gold and Silver, and other Mines and Minerals: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract of Land, and all and singular the Premises hereby granted, with their appurtenances, (except before excepted), unto the said

Basil Babineau his Heirs and Assigns, FOR EVER.
