KNOW YE, That We, of our special grace, certain knowledge, and mere motion, have given  
and granted, and We do, by these Presents, for Us, Our Heirs and Successors, give and grant unto

Oliver Robichaud his Heirs and Assigns,  
a Tract of Land situate in the Parish of Acaduwille  
in the County of Kent in Our Province  
of New Brunswick, and bounded as follows, to-wit -

Beginning at the  
Southwesterly angle of lot number ninety  
on the northerly bank or shore of Stouchebouguet  
River Acaduwille, thence north three degrees  
and thirty minutes east fifty six chains to a  
Spruce tree, thence north eighty six degrees  
and thirty minutes west sixteen chains  
to a fir tree thence south three degrees and  
thirty minutes west sixty five chains to the  
northerly bank or shore of the above mentioned  
river and thence following the various courses  
thereof down stream in an easterly direction  
to the place of beginning containing one  
Hundred acres more or less and distinguished  
as lot number ninety one in Acaduwille

and Silver, and other Mines and Minerals: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said Tract of Land,  
and all and singular the Premises hereby granted, with their appurtenances, (except before excepted), unto the said  
Oliver Robichaud his Heirs and Assigns, FOR EVER.  
PROVIDED ALWAYS, and this present Grant is upon condition, that the same Grant be registered in the Secretary's  
Office of Our said Province of New Brunswick, to which Registry shall be attached a Duplicate of the Plan hereunto  
annexed.

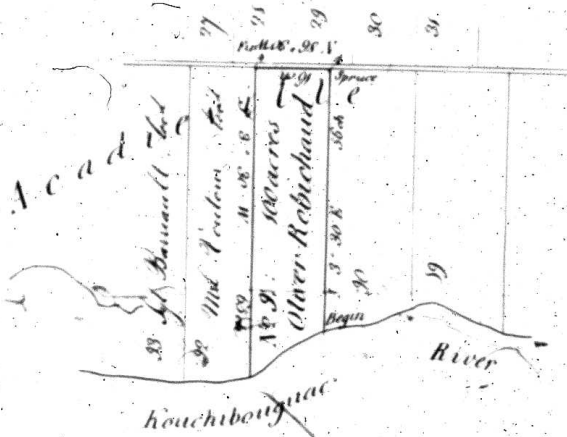
