KNOW YE, That We, of our Our special grace, certain knowledge, and mere motion, have given
and granted, and We do, by these Presents, for Us, Our Heirs and Successors, give and grant unto

Vital Henry *lise* *Heirs and Assigns,*
a Tract of Land situate in the Parish of Acadiville

in the County of Kent *B* in Our Province
of New Brunswick, and bounded as follows, to-wit:-

I Beginning at a
beech tree standing on the south western side of
a reserved road at the north western angle of lot
number fifty one in Acadiville located to I
Vautour thence running by the magnet south
twenty degrees and thirty minutes west fifty chains
thence south sixtynine degrees and thirty minutes
west twenty chains thence north twenty degrees
and thirty minutes east fifty chains to a beech tree
standing on the south western side of above
mentioned road and thence along the same
south sixtynine degrees and thirty minutes
east twenty chains to the place of beginning
Containing One Hundred acres more or less
and distinguished as lot number fifty
three in Acadiville Settlement

and also particularly described or marked on the Plot or Plan of Survey hereunto annexed; together with all profits,


