KNOW YE, That We, of our Our special grace, certain knowledge, and mere motion, have given and granted, and We do, by these Presents, for Us, Our Heirs and Successors, give and grant unto

George Gould his Heirs and Assigns,

a Tract of Land situate in the Parish of Acadieville
in the County of Gloucester in Our Province
of New Brunswick, and bounded as follows, to-wit:-

Beginning at a Stake standing on the northern side of a reserved road at the south eastern angle of lot number One Hundred and twenty one purchased by Brins Richard in the Third Tier North of Rouchibouque River in Acadieville Settlement, thence running by the magnet north three degrees and twenty minutes east eighty Chains, thence east eightysix degrees and thirty minutes east twelve Chains and fifty links to another Stake thence south three degrees and twenty minutes west eighty Chains to another Stake standing on the northern side of the above mentioned road and thence along the same north eighty six degrees and thirty minutes west twelve Chains and fifty links to the place of beginning containing One hundred acres more or less and distinguished as lot number One hundred and twenty two in the third tier of lots north of the Rouchibouque River in Acadieville Settlement.
