His Majesty King George the Third, by the Grace of GOD, of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland,
QUEEN, Defender of the Faith, &c. To all to whom these Presents shall come, Greeting:

KNOW YE, That We, of our Our special grace, certain knowledge, and mere motion, have given and granted, and We do, by these Presents, for Us, Our Heirs and Successors, give and grant unto

George Gould his Heirs and Assigns,
a Tract of Land situate in the Parish of Acadewille
in the County of Gloucester Our Province
of New Brunswick, and bounded as follows, to-wit:—

Beginning at a stake standing on the northern side of a reserved road at the south eastern angle of lot number One Hundred and twenty one purchased by Brown Richard in the Third Tier North of Kouchibouguac River in Acadewille Settlement, thence running by the magnet north three degrees and twenty minutes east eighty Chains, thence south eighty six degrees and thirty minutes east twelve Chains and fifty links to another stake thence south three degrees and twenty minutes west eighty Chains to another stake standing on the northern side of the above mentioned road and thence along the same north eighty six degrees and thirty minutes west twelve Chains and fifty links to the place of beginning containing One hundred acres more or less and distinguished as lot number One Hundred and twenty two in the Third Tier of lots north of the Kouchibouguac River in Acadewille Settlement

and also particularly described or marked on the Plot or Plan of Survey hereunto annexed; together with all profits, commodities, hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever thereunto belonging, or in any wise appertaining; except and reserved, nevertheless, out of this present Grant, to Us, Our Heirs and Successors, all Coals, and also all Gold and Silver, and other Mines and Minerals: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract of Land, and all and singular the Premises hereby granted, with their appurtenances, (except before excepted), unto the said George Gould his Heirs and Assigns, FOR EVER.

PROVIDED ALWAYS, and this present Grant is upon condition, that the same Grant be registered in the Secretary's Office of Our said Province of New Brunswick, to which Registry shall be attached a Duplicate of the Plan hereunto annexed.
