KNOW YE, That We, of Our special grace, certain knowledge, and mere  
granted, and We do, by these Presents, for Us, Our Heirs and Successors, give and grant unto  
*George W. Loggie his* Heirs and Assigns,  
a Tract of Land situate in the Parish of *Nelson*  
in the County of *Northumberland* and in Our Province  
of New Brunswick, and bounded as follows, to wit:—

*Beginning at a  
spruce tree standing on the eastern side of  
the Intercolonial Railway Reservation at  
the south west angle of lot number twenty  
five in Deputy Crocker's Survey on East  
Branch of Barnaby's River in the Year  
Eighteen Hundred and Seventy three  
beginning by the magnet North eighty nine  
degrees east fifty Chains crossing the said  
east Branch of Barnaby's River in that  
distance three South one degree east two  
Chains and fifty links three South seven  
degrees and thirty minutes east two Chains  
three South eighty nine degrees West fifty  
Chains to a spruce tree standing on the eastern  
side of the above mentioned Intercolonial Railway  
Reservation and thence along the same following the various courses  
thereof in a westerly direction crossing the aforesaid east Branch of  
Barnaby's River to the place of beginning, containing one hundred  
Acres more or less and distinguished as lot number twenty  
five on the eastern side of the Intercolonial Railway*

and also particularly described or marked on the Plot or Plan of Survey hereunto annexed; together with all profits,  
commodities, hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever thereunto belonging, or in any wise appertaining; except  
and reserved, nevertheless, out of this Present Grant, to Us, Our Heirs and Successors, all Coals, and also all Gold  
and Silver, and other Mines and Minerals; TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said Land,  
and all and singular the Premises hereby granted, with their appurtenances, (except before excepted) unto the said  
*George W. Loggie his* Heirs and Assigns, FOR EVER.  
PROVIDED ALWAYS, and this present Grant is upon condition, that the same Grant be registered in the Secretary's  
Office of Our said Province of New Brunswick, to which Registry shall be attached a Duplicate of the Plan hereunto  
annexed.

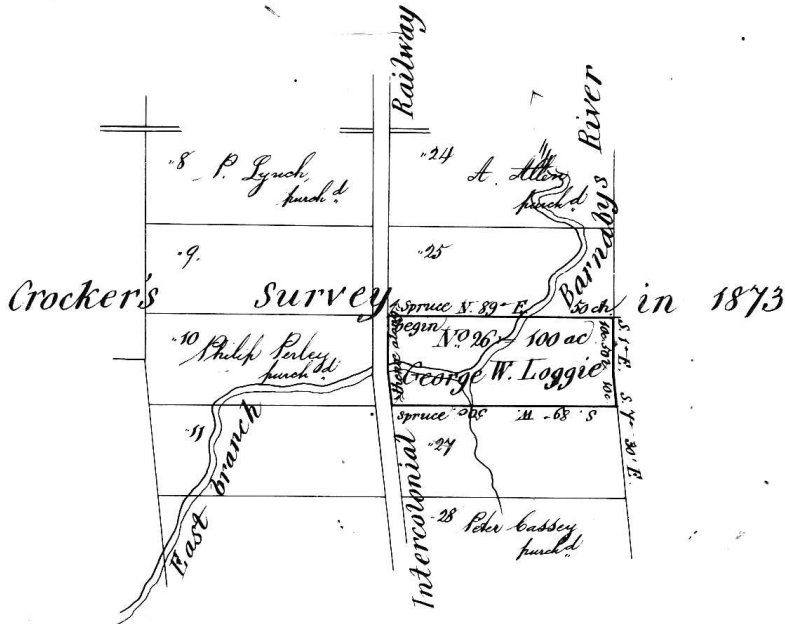
