QUEEN, Defender of the Faith, &c. To all to whom these Presents shall come, Greeting :

KNOW YE, That We, of Our special grace, certain knowledge, and mere motion, have given and granted, and We do, by these Presents, for Us, Our Heirs and Successors, give and grant unto

Etienne Poirrier his Heirs and Assigns,
a Tract of Land situate in the Parish of *Acadewille*
in the County of *Kent* in Our Province
of New Brunswick, and bounded as follows, to-wit:—

*Beginning at
a birch tree standing on the eastern
side of a reserved road at the south
west angle of lot number seventy seven
granted to S. Thibodeau in Acadewille
Settlement, thence running by the magnet
south sixty nine degrees and thirty minutes
east fifty chains to a spruce tree thence south
twenty degrees and thirty minutes west
twenty chains thence north sixty nine
degrees and thirty minutes west fifty
chains to a hemlock tree standing on
the eastern side of the above mentioned
road and thence along the same north
twenty degrees and thirty minutes east
twenty chains to the place of beginning
Containing One Hundred acres more
or less and distinguished as lot number
Twenty nine in Acadewille Settlement,*

and also particularly described or marked on the Plot or Plan of Survey hereunto annexed; together with all profits, commodities, hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever thereunto belonging, or in any wise appertaining; except and reserved, nevertheless, out of this Present Grant, to Us, Our Heirs and Successors, all Coals, and also all Gold and Silver, and other Mines and Minerals; TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said *tract* of Land, and all and singular the Premises hereby granted, with their appurtenances, (except before excepted) unto the said *Etienne Poirrier his* Heirs and Assigns, FOR EVER.
PROVIDED ALWAYS, and this present Grant is upon condition, that the same Grant be registered in the Secretary's Office of Our said Province of New Brunswick, to which Registry shall be attached a Duplicate of the Plan hereunto annexed.
