Victoria, by the Grace of GOD, of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland,
QUEEN, Defender of the Faith, &c. To all to whom these Presents shall come, *Greeting* :

KNOW YE, That We, of Our special grace, certain knowledge, and mere motion, have given and granted, and We do, by these Presents, for Us, Our Heirs and Successors, give and grant unto

Jude Gallant his Heirs and Assigns,
a Tract of Land situate in the Parish of *Acadewille*
in the County of *Kent* in Our Province
of New Brunswick, and bounded as follows, to wit:—

*Beginning at a
Spruce tree standing on the northern side of the
settlement road at the south east angle of lot number
nin located to Basile O. Dagle in the second tier
of Acadewille Settlement north of Kouchibouguac
River then running by the magnet north three
degrees and thirty minutes east eighty chains three
south eighty six degrees and thirty minutes east
twelve chains and fifty links three south
three degrees and thirty minutes west eighty chains
to a maple tree standing on the northern side
of the above mentioned settlement road and
thence along the same north eighty six degrees
and thirty minutes west twelve chains and
fifty links to the place of beginning containing
one Hundred acres more or less and distric
quashed as lot number ten in the second tier
north of Kouchibouguac river in Acadewille
Settlement*

and also particularly described or marked on the Plot or Plan of Survey hereunto annexed; together with all profits, commodities, hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever thereunto belonging, or in any wise appertaining; except and reserved, nevertheless, out of this Present Grant, to Us, Our Heirs and Successors, all Coals, and also all Gold and Silver, and other Mines and Minerals; TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said *tract* of Land, and all and singular the Premises hereby granted, with their appurtenances, (except before excepted) unto the said *Jude Gallant his* Heirs and Assigns, FOR EVER.

PROVIDED ALWAYS, and this present Grant is upon condition, that the same Grant be registered in the Secretary's Office of Our said Province of New Brunswick, to which Registry shall be attached a Duplicate of the Plan hereunto annexed.
