QUEEN, Defender of the Faith, &c. To all to whom these Presents shall come, Greeting :

KNOW YE. That We, of Our special grace, certain knowledge, and mere motion, have given and
granted, and We do, by these Presents, for Us, Our Heirs and Successors, give and grant unto

Amelia Gallant Bristol his Heirs and Assigns,
a Tract of Land situate in the Parish of Aeadieville
in the County of Kent in Our Province

of New Brunswick, and bounded as follows, to wit:—

Beginning at
a maple tree standing on the northern
side of the settlement road at the south
east angle of lot number two purchased
by Judo Gallant in the second tier of Aeadie-
ville settlement north of Kouchibougué
river, thence running by the magnet north
three degrees and thirty minutes east eighty
chains, thence south eighty six degrees and
thirty minutes east twenty five chains, thence
south three degrees and thirty minutes west
eighty chains to a fir tree standing on the
northern side of the above mentioned
settlement road, and thence along the same
north eighty six degrees and thirty minutes
west twenty five chains to the place of
beginning containing two hundred
acres more or less and distinguished as lots
numbers eleven and twelve in the second
tier of Aeadieville, north of Kouchibougué
river

and also particularly described or marked on the Plot or Plan of Survey hereunto annexed; together with all profits,
commodities, hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever thereunto belonging, or in any wise appertaining; except
and reserved, nevertheless, out of this Present Grant, to Us, Our Heirs and Successors, all Coals, and also all Gold
and Silver, and other Mines and Minerals; TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract of Land,
and all and singular the Premises hereby granted, with their appurtenances, (except before excepted) unto the said
Amelia Gallant Bristol his Heirs and Assigns, FOR EVER.

Office of Our said Province of New Brunswick, to which Registry shall be attached a Duplicate of the Plan hereunto
annexed.
