Beginning at a fir tree standing on the southern side of a reserved road at the northwestern angle of lot number eighty eight granted to John Fautour in Acadiville settlement; thence running by the Magnet, North eighty six degrees and thirty minutes West, along the said reserved road, nineteen chains and fifty links to a beech tree thence South three degrees and thirty minutes West fifty two chains or to the northern bank or shore of Kouchibouguac River; thence along the same following the various courses thereof down stream in an easterly direction with a rectangular distance of nineteen chains and fifty links; and thence North three degrees and thirty minutes East fifty six chains to the place of beginning. Containing one hundred acres more or less and distinguished as lot number eighty nine in Acadiville settlement
