QUEEN, Defender of the Faith, &c. To all to whom these Presents shall come, Greeting :

KNOW YE. That We, of Our special grace, certain knowledge, and mere motion, have given and
granted, and We do, by these Presents, for Us, Our Heirs and Successors, give and grant unto

Thomas White his Heirs and Assigns,
a Tract of Land situate in the Parish of *Nelson*
in the County of *Northumberland* in Our Province
of New Brunswick, and bounded as follows, to wit:—

*Beginning at a
stake standing on the south eastern side
of a reserved road at the most western
angle of lot number twenty One Rogerville
Settlement. thence running by the magnetic
south forty degrees east sixty seven chains
thence south fifty degrees west fifteen chains
thence north forty degrees west sixty seven
chains to a beech tree standing on the south
eastern side of the aforesaid reserved road
and thence along the same north fifty degrees
east fifteen chains to the place of beginning
containing One Hundred aces more or less
and distinguished as lot number twenty in
Rogerville Settlement*

and also particularly described or marked on the Plot or Plan of Survey hereunto annexed; together with all profits,
commodities, hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever thereunto belonging, or in any wise appertaining; except
and reserved, nevertheless, out of this Present Grant, to Us, Our Heirs and Successors, all Coals, and also all Gold
and Silver, and other Mines and Minerals; TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said *tract* of Land,
and all and singular the Premises hereby granted, with their appurtenances, (except before excepted) unto the said

Thomas White his Heirs and Assigns, FOR EVER.

Office of Our said Province of New Brunswick, to which Registry shall be attached a Duplicate of the Plan hereunto
annexed.
