QUEEN, Defender of the Faith, &c. To all to whom these Presents shall come, Greeting:

KNOW YE, That We, of Our special grace, certain knowledge, and mere motion, have given and granted, and We do, by these Presents, for Us, Our Heirs and Successors, give and grant unto

Lewis Casey his Heirs and Assigns,

a Tract of Land situate in the Parish of Acadiaville in the County of Kent in Our Province

of New Brunswick, and bounded as follows, to-wit:—

Beginning at a hemlock tree standing on the southeastern side of a reserved road at the southwest angle of lot letter I. purchased by Athanas White in Rogersville thence running by the magnet south fifty degrees east fifty chains thence south forty degrees west twenty chains thence north fifty degrees west fifty chains to a spruce tree standing on the southeastern side of the aforesaid reserved road, and thence along the same north forty degrees east twenty chains to the place of beginning containing One Hundred acres more or less, and distinguished as lot letter F in Rogersville Settlement

and also particularly described or marked on the Plot or Plan of Survey hereunto annexed; together with all profits, commodities, hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever thereunto belonging, or in any wise appertaining; except and reserved, nevertheless, out of this Present Grant, to Us, Our Heirs and Successors, all Coals, and also all Gold and Silver, and other Mines and Minerals; TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract of Land, and all and singular the Premises hereby granted, with their appurtenances, (except before excepted) unto the said

Lewis Casey his Heirs and Assigns, FOR EVER.

PROVIDED ALWAYS, and this present Grant is upon condition, that the same Grant be registered in the Secretary's Office of Our said Province of New Brunswick, to which Registry shall be attached a Duplicate of the Plan hereunto annexed.
