QUEEN, Defender of the Faith, &c. To all to whom these Presents shall come, Greeting :

KNOW YE. That We, of Our special grace, certain knowledge, and mere motion, have given and granted, and We do, by these Presents, for Us, Our Heirs and Successors, give and grant unto

Edward White his Heirs and Assigns,

a Tract of Land situate in the Parish of Nelson and Readsville
in the County of Northumberland and Kent in Our Province

of New Brunswick, and bounded as follows, to wit:—

Beginning at a beech tree standing on the northwestern side of a reserved road at the most eastern angle of lot letter D— purchased by Aman Byr in Rogerville Settlement. thence running by the magnet North fifty degrees West fifty Chains thence North forty degrees East twenty Chains thence thence South fifty degrees East One Hundred and One Chains passing a beech and birch tree and Crossing the aforesaid reserved road in that distance thence South forty degrees West twenty Chains and thence North fifty degrees West fifty one Chains passing another beech tree and crossing the aforesaid reserved road to the place of beginning Excepting nevertheless out of the above described tract the reserved road running through the same. Containing Two Hundred acres more or less and distinguished as Lots letters E. and F. in Rogerville Settlement

and also particularly described or marked on the Plot or Plan of Survey hereunto annexed; together with all profits, commodities, hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever thereunto belonging, or in any wise appertaining; except and reserved, nevertheless, out of this Present Grant, to Us, Our Heirs and Successors, all Coals, and also all Gold and Silver, and other Mines and Minerals; TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract of Land, and all and singular the Premises hereby granted, with their appurtenances, (except before excepted) unto the said Edward White his Heirs and Assigns, FOR EVER. PROVIDED ALWAYS, and this present Grant is upon condition; that the same Grant be registered in the Secretary's Office of Our said Province of New Brunswick, to which Registry shall be attached a Duplicate of the Plan hereunto annexed.

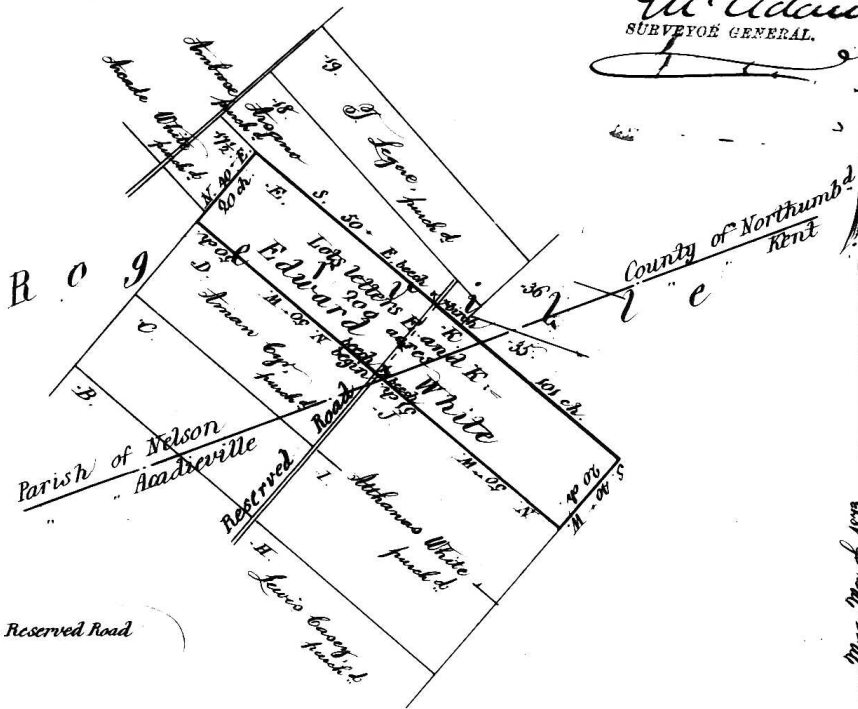
