Silvan Bariault goes Acadieville Kent

Victoria, by the Grace of GOD, of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland,

QUEEN, Defender of the Faith, &c. To all to whom these Presents shall come, Greeting :

KNOW YE, That We, of Our special grace, certain knowledge, and mere motion, have given and granted, and We do, by these Presents, for Us, Our Heirs and Successors, give and grant unto

Silvan Bariault his Heirs and Assigns,

a Tract of Land situate in the Parish of Acadieville

in the County of Kent in Our Province

of New Brunswick, and bounded as follows, to wit:—

Beginning at a Hemlock tree standing on the southern side of the Settlement road at the north east angle of lot number ninety four granted to Antoine Shebeau in Acadieville Settlement, thence running by the square south three degrees and thirty minutes west sixty seven Chains to the northern bank or shore of Konehobiquet River thence along the same following the various Courses thereof in an easterly direction down Stream with a rectangular distance of fourteen Chains and twenty five links, thence north three degrees and thirty minutes east sixty seven Chains to a bush tree standing on the southern side of the aforesaid Settlement road and thence along the same north eighty six degrees and thirty minutes west fourteen Chains and twenty five links to the place of beginning containing ninety five acres more or less and distinguished as lot number ninety three in Acadieville Settlement

and also particularly described or marked on the Plot or Plan of Survey hereunto annexed; together with all profits, commodities, hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever thereunto belonging, or in any wise appertaining; except and reserved, nevertheless, out of this Present Grant, to Us, Our Heirs and Successors, all Coals, and also all Gold and Silver, and other Mines and Minerals; TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract of Land,

and all and singular the Premises hereby granted, with their appurtenances, (except before excepted) unto the said Silvan Bariault his Heirs and Assigns, FOR EVER.

PROVIDED ALWAYS, and this present Grant is upon condition, that the same Grant be registered in the Secretary's Office of Our said Province of New Brunswick, to which Registry shall be attached a Duplicate of the Plan hereunto annexed.
