Victoria, by the Grace of GOD, of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland,  
QUEEN, Defender of the Faith, &c. To all to whom these Presents shall come, Greeting :

KNOW YE, That We, of Our special grace, certain knowledge, and mere motion, have given and granted, and We do, by these Presents, for Us, Our Heirs and Successors, give and grant unto

Andrew Marten his Heirs and Assigns,  
a Tract of Land situate in the Parish of Aquadewille

in the County of Kent in Our Province  
of New Brunswick, and bounded as follows, to wit:—

Beginning at a Stake standing on the south eastern side of a reserved road at the north northern angle of lot number twenty five purchased by Dominique Poirier in Aquadewille Settlement thence running by the Magnet South sixty nine degrees and thirty minutes East fifty chains thence north twenty degrees and thirty minutes East forty chains to a beech tree standing at the south western side of another reserved road thence along the same north sixty nine degrees and thirty minutes West fifty chains to a spruce tree standing on the south eastern side of the first aforesaid reserved road and thence along the same south twenty degrees and thirty minutes West forty chains to the place of beginning. Containing Two Hundred Acres more or less and distinguished as lots numbers seventy one and seventy three in Aquadewille Settlement

and also particularly described or marked on the Plot or Plan of Survey hereunto annexed; together with all profits, commodities, hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever thereunto belonging, or in any wise appertaining; except and reserved, nevertheless, out of this Present Grant, to Us, Our Heirs and Successors, all Coals, and also all Gold and Silver, and other Mines and Minerals; TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract of Land,

and all and singular the Premises hereby granted, with their appurtenances, (except before excepted) unto the said Andrew Marten his Heirs and Assigns, FOR EVER.

PROVIDED ALWAYS, and this present Grant is upon condition, that the same Grant be registered in the Secretary's Office of Our said Province of New Brunswick, to which Registry shall be attached a Duplicate of the Plan hereunto annexed.
