R. D. Wilmot Victoria, by the Grace of GOD, of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland,
QUEEN, Defender of the Faith, &c. To all to whom these Presents shall come, Greeting:

KNOW YE, That We, of Our special grace, certain knowledge, and mere motion, have given and granted, and We do, by these Presents, for Us, Our Heirs and Successors, give and grant unto

George Perry his Heirs and Assigns,
a Tract of Land situate in the Parish of *Acaduwille*
in the County of *Kent* in Our Province
of New Brunswick, and bounded as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at a stake standing on the northern side of a reserved road at the southwest angle of lot number one purchased by Robert Wilson in Acaduwille Settlement thence running by the Inagut North three degrees and forty minutes east twenty eight Chains to another stake thence north eighty six degrees and twenty minutes west thirty nine Chains to a pine tree standing on the Eastern side of the Intercolonial Railway and reservation thence along the same South seven degrees and thirty minutes east twenty eight chains and fifty links to another stake standing on the northern side of the aforesaid reserved road, and thence along the same South eighty six degrees and twenty minutes east thirty four Chains to the place of beginning containing one hundred acres more or less and distinguished by lot number one recorded and shown on the eastern side of the Intercolonial Railway North of Rouchbouquet River

and also particularly described or marked on the Plot or Plan of Survey hereunto annexed; together with all profits, commodities, hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever thereunto belonging, or in any wise appertaining; except and reserved, nevertheless, out of this Present Grant, to Us, Our Heirs and Successors, all Coals, and also all Gold and Silver, and other Mines and Minerals; TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said *tract* of Land, and all and singular the Premises hereby granted, with their appurtenances, (except before excepted) unto the said *George Perry his* Heirs and Assigns, FOR EVER.
PROVIDED ALWAYS, and this present Grant is upon condition, that the same Grant be registered in the Secretary's Office of Our said Province of New Brunswick, to which Registry shall be attached a Duplicate of the Plan hereunto annexed.

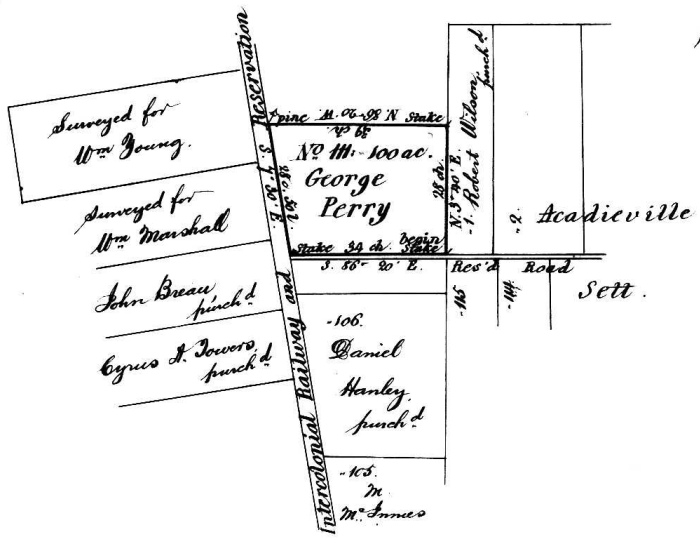
