Victoria, by the Grace of GOD, of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland,
QUEEN, Defender of the Faith, &c. To all to whom these Presents shall come, Greeting :

KNOW YE, That We, of Our special grace, certain knowledge, and mere motion, have given and granted, and We do, by these Presents, for Us, Our Heirs and Successors, give and grant unto

Charles Beaulieu his Heirs and Assigns,
a Tract of Land situate in the Parish of Acadewille
in the County of Kent in Our Province
of New Brunswick, and bounded as follows, to-wit:—

Beginning at a
dry fir tree standing on the eastern side of a reserved
road at the north west angle of lot letter C. granted
to Laurent Gallant in Acadewille Settlement three
running by the magnet south eighty six degrees and
thirty minutes east fifty seven Chains three north
three degrees and thirty minutes east twelve Chains
and fifty links to a spruce tree three north eighty
six degrees and thirty minutes west fifty seven
Chains to a stake standing on the eastern side
of the aforesaid reserved road and thence along
the same south three degrees and thirty minutes
west twelve Chains and fifty links to the place
of beginning containing Seventy acres more
or less and distinguished as lot letter D in
Acadewille Settlement

and also particularly described or marked on the Plot or Plan of Survey hereunto annexed; together with all profits,
commodities, hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever thereunto belonging, or in any wise appertaining; except
and reserved, nevertheless, out of this Present Grant, to Us, Our Heirs and Successors, all Coals, and also all Gold
and Silver, and other Mines and Minerals; TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract of Land,
and all and singular the Premises hereby granted, with their appurtenances, (except before excepted) unto the said
Charles Beaulieu his Heirs and Assigns, FOR EVER.
PROVIDED ALWAYS, and this present Grant is upon condition, that the same Grant be registered in the Secretary's
Office of Our said Province of New Brunswick, to which Registry shall be attached a Duplicate of the Plan hereunto
annexed.
