QUEEN, Defender of the Faith, &c. To all to whom these Presents shall come, Greeting :

KNOW YE, That We, of Our special grace, certain knowledge, and mere motion, have given and granted, and We do, by these Presents, for Us, Our Heirs and Successors, give and grant unto

Charles Hache, his Heirs and Assigns,

a Tract of Land situate in the Parish of Nelson
in the County of Northumberland in Our Province
of New Brunswick, and bounded as follows, to-wit:—

Beginning at a
Hemlock tree standing on the northwestern
side of a reserved road at the most southern
angle of lot number two granted to Pasifique
Margais in Rogerville Settlement thence
running by the magnetic north forty degrees
west sixty seven Chains thence south thirty
degrees west fifteen Chains and fifty links
to a spruce tree thence south forty degrees
east sixty seven Chains to a beech tree
standing on the northwestern side of the
aforesaid reserved road and thence along
the same north thirty degrees east fifteen
Chains and fifty links to the place beginning
containing one hundred acres more or
less and distinguished as lot number nine
in Rogerville Settlement

and also particularly described or marked on the Plot or Plan of Survey hereunto annexed; together with all profits, commodities, hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever thereunto belonging, or in any wise appertaining; except and reserved, nevertheless, out of this Present Grant, to Us, Our Heirs and Successors, all Coals, and also all Gold and Silver, and other Mines and Minerals; TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract of Land, and all and singular the Premises hereby granted, with their appurtenances, (except before excepted) unto the said Charles Hache his Heirs and Assigns, FOR EVER. PROVIDED ALWAYS, and this present Grant is upon condition, that the same Grant be registered in the Secretary's Office of Our said Province of New Brunswick, to which Registry shall be attached a Duplicate of the Plan hereunto annexed.

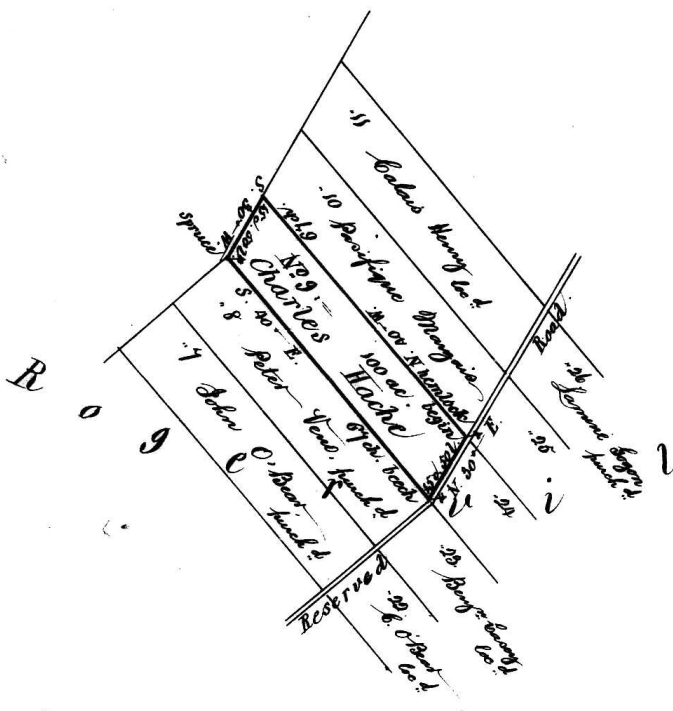
