Victoria, by the Grace of GOD, of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland,
QUEEN, Defender of the Faith, &c. To all to whom these Presents shall come, Greeting :

KNOW YE, That We, of Our special grace, certain knowledge, and mere motion, have given and granted, and We do, by these Presents, for Us, Our Heirs and Successors, give and grant unto

Arceado White his Heirs and Assigns,
a Tract of Land situate in the Parish of Nelson
in the County of Northumberland in Our Province
of New Brunswick, and bounded as follows, to-wit:—

Beginning at a stake standing on the north western side of a reserved road, at the most southern angle of lot number three granted to Ambrose Arsaur in Rogersville Settlement thence running by the magnet north forty degrees west sixty seven Chains to the south eastern side of another reserved road, thence along the same south fifty degrees west eleven Chains to another stake standing on the ear line of lot fronting in the east side of Intercolonial Railway thence along the said ear line south and down east six Chains and fifty links thence south forty degrees east sixty two Chains to a spruce tree standing on the north western side of the first before said reserved road and thence along the same north fifty degrees east fifteen Chains to the place of beginning containing One Hundred acres more or less and distinguished as lot number two in Rogersville Settlement

and also particularly described or marked on the Plot or Plan of Survey hereunto annexed; together with all profits, commodities, hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever thereunto belonging, or in any wise appertaining; except and reserved, nevertheless, out of this Present Grant, to Us, Our Heirs and Successors, all Coals, and also all Gold and Silver, and other Mines and Minerals; TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract of Land, and all and singular the Premises hereby granted, with their appurtenances, (except before excepted) unto the said Arceado White his Heirs and Assigns, FOR EVER. PROVIDED ALWAYS, and this present Grant is upon condition, that the same Grant be registered in the Secretary's Office of Our said Province of New Brunswick, to which Registry shall be attached a Duplicate of the Plan hereunto annexed.

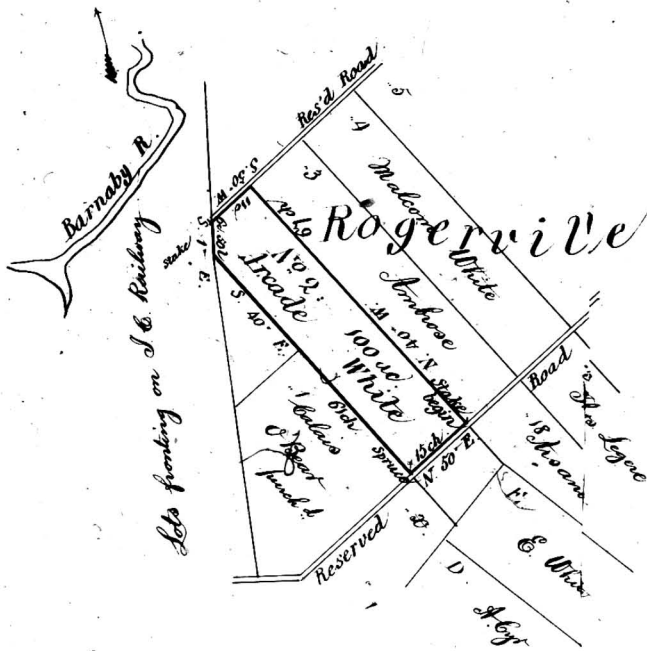
