Beginning at a Spruce tree standing on the eastern side of the Intercolonial Railway and reservation at the northwest angle of lot number eighteen granted to Simon White in Barnaby River Settlement, thence running by the said angle north eighty nine degrees east fifty chains thence north one degree west nineteen chains and fifty links to the Southern side of the road to Collet Settlement, thence along the same South eighty nine degrees west fifty chains to the eastern side of the Railway and reservation aforesaid, and thence along the same south one degree east nineteen chains and fifty links to the place of beginning. Containing One Hundred acres more or less and distinguished as lot number seventeen in Barnaby River Settlement.
