St. Elias Arceneau his Heirs and Assigns,

a Tract of Land situate in the Parish of *Acadiville*
in the County of *Kent* in Our Province

of New Brunswick, and bounded as follows, to wit:—

fir tree standing on the northern side of the settle-
ment road at the southeast angle of lot number
five located to Rubin Cousay in Acadiville Settlement
thence running by the magnet north three degrees
and thirty minutes east eighty chains thence south
eighty six degrees and thirty minutes east twelve
chains and fifty links, thence south three degrees
and thirty minutes west eighty chains to a spruce
tree standing on the northern side of the settlement
road aforesaid, and thence along the same north
eighty six degrees and thirty minutes west twelve
chains and fifty links to the place of beginning

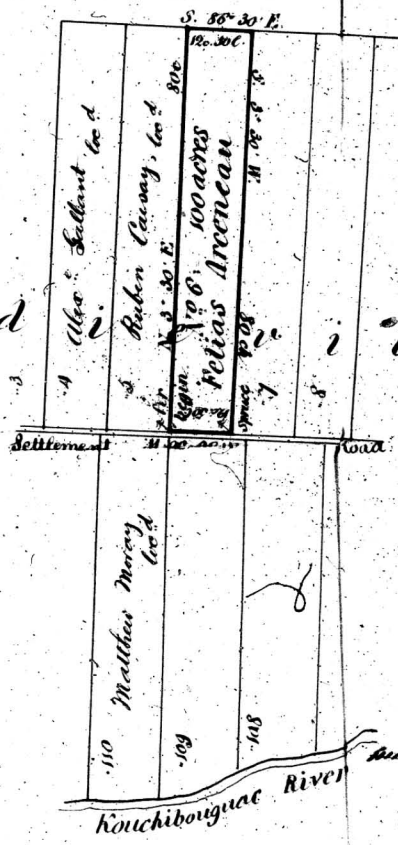
