KNOW YE, That We, of Our special grace, certain knowledge, and mere motion, have given and granted, and We do, by these Presents, for Us, Our Heirs and Successors, give and grant unto

*Jude Hachs his*  
a Tract of Land situate in the Parish of *Nelson*  
in the County of *Northumberland*  
of New Brunswick, and bounded as follows, to wit:—

Heirs and Assigns,

in Our Province

*Beginning at a stake  
standing on the north western side of the Settlement  
road at the most eastern angle of lot number eleven  
purchased by Calais Henry in Rogerville Settlement  
thence running by the magnet with forty degrees west  
sixty seven chains, thence north thirty degrees east  
fifteen chains and fifty links thence south forty  
degrees east sixty seven chains to another stake  
standing on the north western side of the aforesaid  
Settlement road and thence along the same south  
thirty degrees west fifteen chains and fifty links  
to the place of beginning containing one hundred  
aces more or less and distinguished as lot number
