KNOW YE, That We, of Our special grace, certain knowledge, and mere motion, have given and granted, and We do, by these Presents, for Us, Our Heirs and Successors, give and grant unto  
Reverend Marcel F. Richard his Heirs and Assigns,  
a Tract of Land situate in the Parish of Acaedeville in the County of Kent in Our Province of New Brunswick, and bounded as follows, to-wit:—

Beginning at a pine tree standing at the south west angle of lot number thirty eight granted to Dom. Gallant in Acaedeville Settlement, thence running by the magnet south eighty six degrees and thirty minutes east eighty chains to another pine tree thence south three degrees and thirty minutes west twelve chains and fifty links to a birch tree, thence north eighty six degrees and thirty minutes west eighty chains to another birch tree and thence north three degrees and thirty minutes east twelve chains and fifty links to the place of beginning containing one hundred acres more or less adjoining southerly lots numbers thirty eight thirty nine forty and forty one in Acaedeville

and also particularly described or marked on the Plot or Plan of Survey hereunto annexed; together with all profits, commodities, hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever thereunto belonging, or in any wise appertaining; except and reserved, nevertheless, out of this present Grant, to Us, Our Heirs and Successors, all Coals, and also all Gold and Silver, and other Mines and Minerals: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said ~~tract~~ of Land, and all and singular the Premises hereby granted, with their appurtenances, (except before excepted), unto the said  
Reverend Marcel F. Richard his Heirs and Assigns, FOR EVER.
