KNOW YE, That We, of Our special grace, certain knowledge, and mere motion, have given
and granted, and We do, by these Presents, for Us, Our Heirs and Successors, give and grant unto

Joseph S. Casey his Heirs and Assigns,
a Tract of Land situate in the Parish of Rogerville in the
County of Northumberland in Our Province of New Brunswick,
and bounded as follows, to-wit:—

Beginning at a birch
tree standing at the southern side of a
reserved road at the north west angle of
lot number eighty located to Thomas Herbert
in Pleasant Ridge Settlement thence running
by the magnet south one degree east fifty
chains thence south eighty nine degrees west
twenty chains thence north one degree west fifty
chains to a stake standing at the southern
side of a presaid reserved road and thence
along the same north eighty nine degrees east
twenty chains to the place of beginning con-
taining one hundred acres more or less
and distinguished as lot number eighty one
in Pleasant Ridge Settlement

and also particularly described or marked on the Plot or Plan of Survey hereunto annexed; together with all profits,
