R. D. Wilnot Victoria, by the Grace of GOD, of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland,
QUEEN, Defender of the Faith, &c. To all to whom these Presents shall come, Greeting :

KNOW YE, That We, of Our special grace, certain knowledge, and mere motion, have given
and granted, and We do, by these Presents, for Us, Our Heirs and Successors, give and grant unto

Basil O Daigle his Heirs and Assigns,
a Tract of Land situate in the Parish of Aeaduville, in the
County of Kent in Our Province of New Brunswick,
and bounded as follows, to-wit:—

Beginning at a spruce
tree standing at the northern side of a
reserved road at the southwest angle
of lot number ten granted to Judo Gallant
in Aeaduville Settlement thence running
by the magnet north three degrees and
thirty minutes east eighty chains to the southern
side of another reserved road thence along
the same north eighty six degrees and thirty
minutes west twelve chains and fifty
links thence south three degrees and thirty
minutes west eighty chains to a fir tree
standing on the northern side of the
first aforesaid reserved road and thence
along the same south eighty six degrees and
thirty minutes east twelve chains and fifty
links to the place of beginning Containing
One Hundred aces more or less and dis-
tinguished as lot number nine in Aeadu-
ville Settlement

and also particularly described or marked on the Plot or Plan of Survey hereunto annexed; together with all profits,
commodities, hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever thereunto belonging, or in any wise appertaining; except
and reserved, nevertheless, out of this present Grant, to Us, Our Heirs and Successors, all Coals, and also all Gold
and Silver, and other Mines and Minerals: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract of Land,
and all and singular the Premises hereby granted, with their appurtenances, (except before excepted), unto the said

Basil O. Daigle his Heirs and Assigns, FOR EVER.

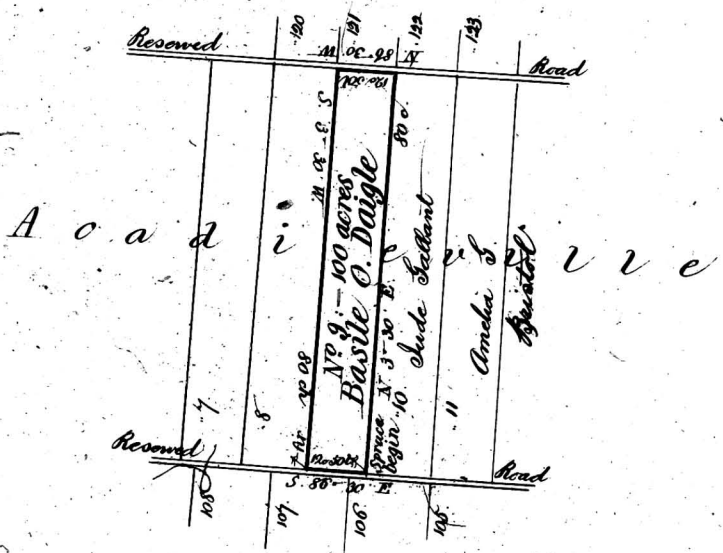
