R. D. Wilmut Victoria, by the Grace of GOD, of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland,  
QUEEN, Defender of the Faith, &c. To all to whom these Presents shall come, Greeting :

KNOW YE, That We, of Our special grace, certain knowledge, and mere motion, have given  
and granted, and We do, by these Presents, for Us, Our Heirs and Successors, give and grant unto

Laurent Arson his Heirs and Assigns,

a Tract of Land situate in the Parish of Aeadwille, in the  
County of Kent in Our Province of New Brunswick,

and bounded as follows, to-wit:—Beginning at a post standing

on the southern side of a reserved road at the north  
west angle of lot number sixty two purchased by  
Alexandre Guimow in Sweden's Brook Settlement  
thence running by the enquet along the said reserved road  
north eighty six degrees and thirty minutes west fifteen  
Chains to another post thence south three degrees and  
thirty minutes west sixty seven chains thence south eighty  
six degrees and thirty minutes east eight chains and fifty  
links or to the west line of lot number thirty granted to James  
Potter thence north three degrees and thirty minutes east twenty  
eight Chains thence south eighty six degrees and thirty minutes  
east six Chains and fifty links or to the western line of the afore-  
said lot number sixty two thence along the same and its pro-  
longation north three degrees and thirty minutes east  
sixty Chains crossing the aforesaid reserved road in that  
distance thence south eighty six degrees and thirty minutes  
east twenty Chains thence south three degrees and thirty minutes west  
fifty Chains to a stake standing on the northern side of aforesaid  
reserved road thence along the same north eighty six degrees and  
thirty minutes west twenty chains and thence south three degrees and  
thirty minutes west one chain to the place of beginning Containing One  
hundred and eighty three acres more or less and distinguished as lots number  
sixty three and sixty four in Sweden's Brook Settlement

and also particularly described or marked on the Plot or Plan of Survey hereunto annexed; together with all profits,  
commodities, hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever thereunto belonging, or in any wise appertaining; except  
and reserved, nevertheless, out of this present Grant, to Us, Our Heirs and Successors, all Coals, and also all Gold  
and Silver, and other Mines and Minerals: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract of Land,  
and all and singular the Premises hereby granted, with their appurtenances, (except before excepted), unto the said

Laurent Arson his Heirs and Assigns, FOR EVER.

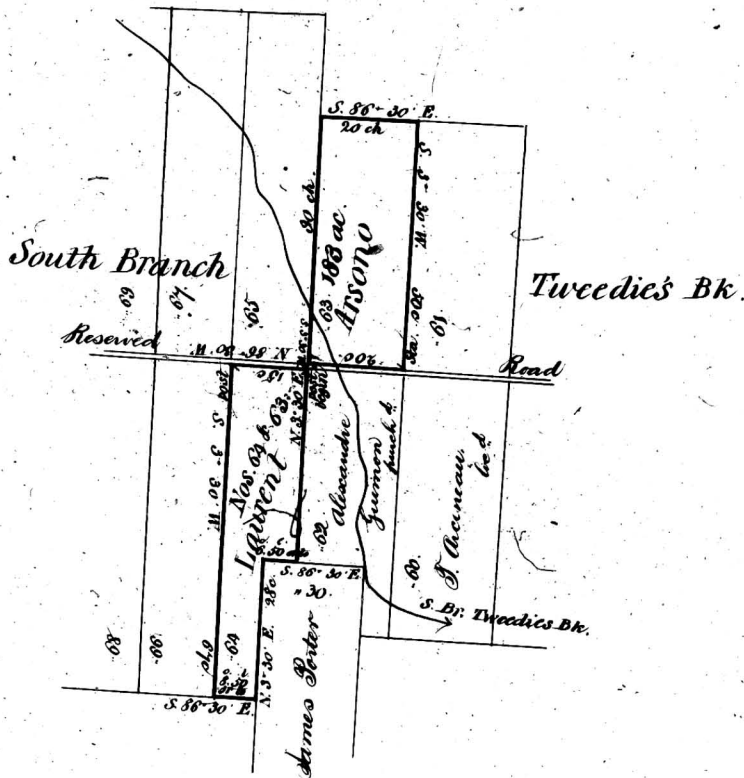
