KNOW YE, That We, of Our special grace, certain knowledge, and mere motion, have given  
and granted, and We do, by these Presents, for Us, Our Heirs and Successors, give and grant unto

Abraham Allen his Heirs and Assigns,  
a Tract of Land situate in the Parish of Rogersville, in the  
County of Albert in Our Province of New Brunswick,

and bounded as follows, to-wit:—

Beginning at a stake  
standing on the southeastern side  
of the Pittenbut road at the most  
western angle of lot number twenty  
two granted to Calais O'Beir in  
Rogersville Pittenbut, thence running  
by the magnet south forty degrees east  
sixty seven Chains thence south fifty  
degrees west fifteen Chains thence  
south forty degrees west sixty seven  
Chains to a stake standing on the south  
eastern side of the aforesaid Pittenbut  
road and thence north fifty degrees east  
fifteen Chains to the place of beginning  
Containing One Hundred acres more  
or less and distinguished as lot number  
twenty two in Rogersville Pittenbut

and also particularly described or marked on the Plot of Plan of Survey hereunto annexed; together with all profits,
