KNOW YE, That We, of Our special grace, certain knowledge, and mere motion, have given and granted, and We do, by these Presents, for Us, Our Heirs and Successors, give and grant unto

*Alfred White his*

Heirs and Assigns,

a Tract of Land situate in the Parish of *Rogersville and Aersduwille* in the

County of *Northumberland and Kent* in Our Province of New Brunswick,

and bounded as follows, to-wit:— *Beginning at a birch tree*

*standing on the north western side of a reserved road at the most eastern angle of lot letter B granted to Antony Casey in Rogersville Settlement thence running by the magnet north fifty degrees west fifty Chains thence north forty degrees east twenty Chains thence south fifty degrees east fifty Chains to a birch tree standing on the north western side of the aforesaid reserved road and thence along the same south forty degrees west twenty Chains to the place of beginning containing One Hundred acres more or less and distinguished as lot letter C in Rogersville Settlement*



and also particularly described or marked on the Plot or Plan of Survey hereunto annexed: together with all profits, commodities, hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever thereunto belonging, or in any wise appertaining; except and reserved, nevertheless, out of this present Grant, to Us, Our Heirs and Successors, all Coals, and also all Gold and Silver, and other Mines and Minerals: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said *tract* of Land, and all and singular the Premises hereby granted, with their appurtenances, (except before excepted), unto the said

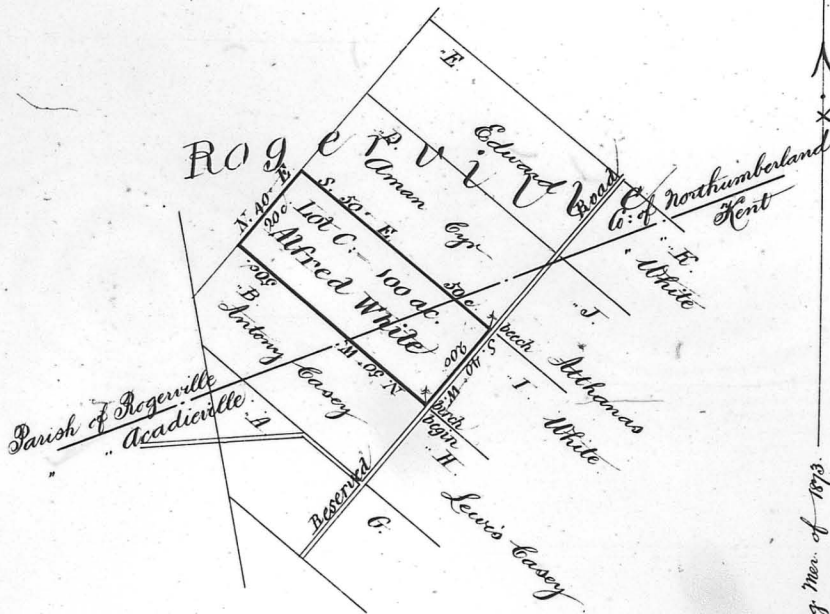
