KNOW YE, That We, of Our special grace, certain knowledge, and mere motion, have given and granted, and We do, by these Presents, for Us, Our Heirs and Successors, give and grant unto

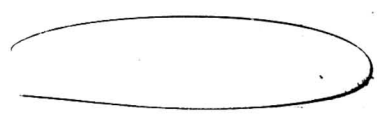
Thomas Breaux his Heirs and Assigns,

a Tract of Land situate in the Parish of *Acadewille* in the

County of *Kent* in Our Province of New Brunswick,

and bounded as follows, to-wit:—*Beginning at a stake*

*Standing at the south east angle of lot number
One Hundred and three on the southern side of
Kouchibouguac River, west of the Intercolonial
Railway thence running by the magnet north
three degrees and fifteen minutes east eighty
One Chains to the southern bank or shore of the
said Kouchibouguac River, thence along the same
following the several Courses thereof in an easterly
and south easterly direction down stream with
a rectangular distance of thirteen Chains
and twenty links thence south three degrees
and fifteen minutes west sixty eight Chains to a
stake and thence north eighty six degrees
and forty five minutes west thirteen Chains
and twenty links to the place of beginning—
Containing One Hundred aces more or
less and distinguished as lot number
One Hundred and two southern side of
Kouchibouguac River west of Intercolonial
Railway*



and also particularly described or marked on the Plot or Plan of Survey hereunto annexed; together with all profits, commodities, hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever thereunto belonging, or in any wise appertaining; except and reserved, nevertheless, out of this present Grant, to Us, Our Heirs and Successors, all Coals, and also all Gold and Silver, and other Mines and Minerals: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said *tract* of Land,

and all and singular the Premises hereby granted, with their appurtenances, (except before excepted), unto the said *Thomas Breaux his* Heirs and Assigns, FOR EVER.

PROVIDED ALWAYS, and this present Grant is upon condition, that the same Grant be Registered in the Secretary's Office of Our said Province of New Brunswick, to which Registry shall be attached a duplicate of the Plan hereunto annexed.

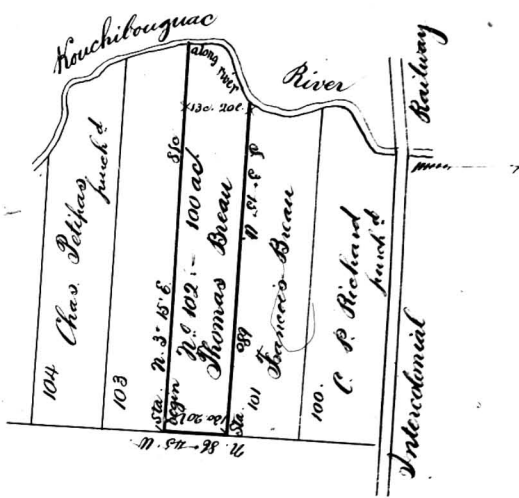
