KNOW YE, That We, of Our special grace, certain knowledge, and mere motion, have given and granted, and We do, by these Presents, for Us, Our Heirs and Successors, give and grant unto

Alexis Collette his

Heirs and Assigns,

a Tract of Land situate in the Parish of Rogerville in the County of Northumberland in Our Province of New Brunswick,

and bounded as follows, to-wit:—Beginning at a Hemlock

tree standing on the southern side of the Settlement road at the northwest angle of lot number seventy seven in Collett settlement east of Intercolonial Railway thence running by the magnet south twenty degrees east seventy one Chains and fifty links thence thence south forty five degrees west fifteen Chains thence north twenty degrees west seventy one Chains and fifty links to a cedar tree standing on the southern side of the aforesaid Settlement road and thence along the same north forty five degrees east fifteen Chains to the place of beginning containing One Hundred acres more or less and distinguished as lot number seventy six in Collett Settlement East of Intercolonial Railway

and also particularly described or marked on the Plot or Plan of Survey hereunto annexed; together with all profits, commodities, hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever thereunto belonging, or in any wise appertaining; except and reserved, nevertheless, out of this present Grant, to Us, Our Heirs and Successors, all Coals, and also all Gold and Silver, and other Mines and Minerals: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract of Land, and all and singular the Premises hereby granted, with their appurtenances, (except before excepted), unto the said

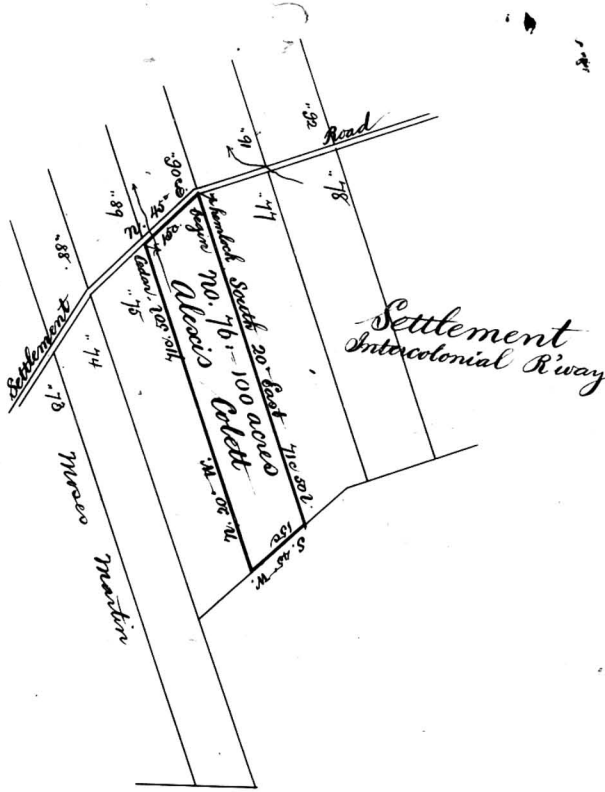
