QUEEN, Defender of the Faith, &c. To all to whom these Presents shall come, Greeting :

KNOW YE, That We, of Our special grace, certain knowledge, and mere motion, have given and granted, and We do, by these Presents, for Us, Our Heirs and Successors, give and grant unto

Alexander Cassy his Heirs and Assigns,
a Tract of Land situate in the Parish of *Rogerville* in the

County of *Northumberland* in Our Province of New Brunswick,

and bounded as follows, to-wit:— *Beginning at a stake*

standing on the eastern side of a reserved road at the most northern angle of lot number eighty eight in Pleasant Ridge Settlement thence running by the magnet south forty five degrees east thirty four Chains and sixty links thence north one degree West fifty four Chains to a spruce tree standing on the south eastern side of the aforesaid reserved road thence along the same south sixty degrees west twenty Chains and thence continuing along the said reserved road south eighteen degrees west twenty Chains to the place of beginning containing seventy five acres more or less and distinguished as lot number eighty seven and one half in Pleasant Ridge Settlement

and also particularly described or marked on the Plot or Plan of Survey hereunto annexed; together with all profits, commodities, hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever thereunto belonging, or in any wise appertaining; except and reserved, nevertheless, out of this present Grant, to Us, Our Heirs and Successors, all Coals, and also all Gold and Silver, and other Mines and Minerals: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said *tract* of Land, and all and singular the Premises hereby granted, with their appurtenances, (except before excepted), unto the said

Alexander Cassy his Heirs and Assigns, FOR EVER.
