KNOW YE, That We, of Our special grace, certain knowledge, and mere motion, have given

and granted, and We do, by these Presents, for Us, Our Heirs and Successors, give and grant unto

Maxime LeBlanc his Heirs and Assigns,

a Tract of Land situate in the Parish of *Acaduwille and Pogeruille* in the

County of *Kent and Northumberland* in Our Province of New Brunswick,

and bounded as follows, to-wit:—

Beginning at a spruce standing on the western side of the Intercolonial Railway and Reservation at the point where a southern line of log number ninety five surveyed for Edward - Harcourt intersects the said Railway and Reservation thence running by the magnet north eighty nine degrees and fifteen minutes west fifty Chains to a cedar tree thence south seven degrees and fifteen minutes east twenty Chains thence south eighty nine degrees and fifteen minutes east fifty Chains to the western side of the Intercolonial Railway and Reservation aforesaid and thence along the same north seven degrees and fifteen minutes west twenty Chains to the place of beginning, Containing one hundred Acres more or less and distinguished as log number ninety seven south of Granville Station

and also particularly described or marked on the Plot or Plan of Survey hereunto annexed; together with all profits, commodities, hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever thereunto belonging, or in any wise appertaining; except and reserved, nevertheless, out of this present Grant, to Us, Our Heirs and Successors, all Coals, and also all Gold and Silver, and other Mines and Minerals: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said *tract* of Land, and all and singular the Premises hereby granted, with their appurtenances, (except before excepted), unto the said

Maxime LeBlanc his Heirs and Assigns, FOR EVER.
