Victoria, by the Grace of GOD, of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland,

QUEEN, Defender of the Faith, &c. To all to whom these Presents shall come, Greeting :

KNOW YE, That We, of Our special grace, certain knowledge, and mere motion, have given and granted, and We do, by these Presents, for Us, Our Heirs and Successors, give and grant unto

Ferdinand LeBlanc his Heirs and Assigns,

a Tract of Land situate in the Parish of Acadville & Roseville in the County of Kent and Northumberland in Our Province of New Brunswick,

and bounded as follows, to-wit:—Beginning at a point on the

eastern side of the Intercolonial Railway, and reservation distant one Chain measured along the same in a southerly direction from South western angle of lot number thirty two granted to Joseph Poirer in Barnaby River Settlement thence running by the magnet along a reserved road, north eighty nine degrees east thirty seven Chains and fifty links to another stake, thence south seven degrees and thirty minutes east twenty seven Chains, thence south eighty nine degrees west thirty seven Chains and fifty links to another stake standing on the eastern side of the aforesaid Intercolonial Railway and reservation, and thence along the same north seven degrees and thirty minutes west twenty seven Chains to the place of beginning. Containing One Hundred acres more or less and distinguished as lot number unity six South of Barnaby River Settlement

and also particularly described or marked on the Plot or Plan of Survey hereunto annexed; together with all profits, commodities, hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever thereunto belonging, or in any wise appertaining; except and reserved, nevertheless, out of this present Grant, to Us, Our Heirs and Successors, all Coals, and also all Gold and Silver, and other Mines and Minerals: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said Tract of Land, and all and singular the Premises hereby granted, with their appurtenances, (except before excepted), unto the said

Ferdinand LeBlanc his Heirs and Assigns, FOR EVER.

PROVIDED ALWAYS, and this present Grant is upon condition, that the same Grant be Registered in the Secretary's Office of Our said Province of New Brunswick, to which Registry shall be attached a duplicate of the Plan hereunto annexed.
