QUEEN, Defender of the Faith, &c. To all to whom these Presents shall come, Greeting :

KNOW YE, That We, of Our special grace, certain knowledge, and mere motion, have given and granted, and We do, by these Presents, for Us, Our Heirs and Successors, give and grant unto

Oliver Parry his Heirs and Assigns,

a Tract of Land situate in the Parish of Acedwille in the

County of Kent in Our Province of New Brunswick,

and bounded as follows, to-wit:—Beginning at a bush

tree standing in the Southern side of a reserved road at the north west angle of lot number Sixty one granted to Mr Vautour in Acedwille settlement thence running by the magnet south twenty degrees and thirty minutes west fifty chains thence north sixty nine degrees and thirty minutes west twenty chains thence north twenty degrees and thirty minutes east fifty chains to a moosewood tree, and thence south sixty nine degrees and thirty minutes east twenty chains to the place of beginning containing One Hundred Acres more or less and distinguished as lot number Sixty three in Acedwille settlement, North Branch W Lewis Brook

and also particularly described or marked on the Plot or Plan of Survey hereunto annexed; together with all profits, commodities, hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever thereunto belonging, or in any wise appertaining; except and reserved, nevertheless, out of this present Grant, to Us, Our Heirs and Successors, all Coals, and also all Gold and Silver, and other Mines and Minerals: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract of Land, and all and singular the Premises hereby granted, with their appurtenances, (except before excepted), unto the said

Oliver Parry his Heirs and Assigns, FOR EVER.

PROVIDED ALWAYS, and this present Grant is upon condition, that the same Grant be Registered in the Secretary's Office of Our said Province of New Brunswick, to which Registry shall be attached a duplicate of the Plan hereunto annexed.
