KNOW YE, That We, of Our special grace, certain knowledge, and mere motion, have given
and granted, and We do, by these Presents, for Us, Our Heirs and Successors, give and grant unto

Dennis Dresdall his Heirs and Assigns,
a Tract of Land situate in the Parish of Aleadville in the
County of Kent in Our Province of New Brunswick,

and bounded as follows, to-wit:—Beginning at a stake

standing on the eastern side of the
Intercolonial Railway and reservation
at the south west angle of lot number
cunity six granted to Ferdinand LeBlanc
South of Carleton Station, thence running
by the magnet north eighty nine degrees east
fifty Chains and fifty links to a spruce tree
thence South One degree east twenty Chains
and fifty links to a stake thence south eighty
nine degrees west forty nine Chains and eighty
links to another stake standing on the eastern
side of the Intercolonial Railway and
reservation aforesaid and thence along
the same north seven degrees and thirty
minutes west with a rectangular distance
of twenty Chains and fifty links to the place
of beginning containing One Hundred

Dennis Dresdall his Heirs and Assigns, FOR EVER.
