Victoria, by the Grace of GOD, of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland,  
QUEEN, Defender of the Faith, &c. To all to whom these Presents shall come, Greeting:

KNOW YE, That We, of Our special grace, certain knowledgè, and mere motion, have given and granted, and We do, by these Presents, for Us, Our Heirs and Successors, give and grant unto

*Placide Richard his* Heirs and Assigns,  
a Tract of Land situate in the Parish of *Headwille*  
in the County of *Kent* in Our Province

of New Brunswick, and bounded as follows, to-wit:—

*Beginning at a cedar tree standing at the north eastern angle of lot number thirty five purchased by Pacima Richard in Rogersville Settlement thence running by the magnet south twenty degrees west eighty Chains to a spruce tree thence south twenty degrees east twelve Chains and fifty links to another spruce tree thence north twenty degrees east eighty Chains to a stake standing in the northern side of the Settlement road running through the above described tract; and thence north twenty degrees west twelve Chains and fifty links to the place of beginning. Excepting the part of the settlement road above mentioned running through the bounds of the above described tract containing One Hundred aces more or less and distinguished as lot number thirty four in Rogersville Settlement*

and also particularly described or marked on the Plot or Plan of Survey hereunto annexed; together with all profits, commodities, hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever thereunto belonging, or in any wise appertaining; except and reserved, nevertheless, out of this present Grant, to Us, Our Heirs and Successors, all Coals, and also all Gold and Silver, and other Mines and Minerals: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said *tract* of Land, and all and singular the Premises hereby granted, with their appurtenances, (except before excepted) unto the said *Placide Richard his* Heirs and Assigns, FOR EVER. PROVIDED ALWAYS, and this present Grant is upon condition, that the same Grant be registered in the Secretary's Office of Our said Province of New Brunswick, to which Registry shall be attached a Duplicate of the Plan hereunto annexed.
