KNOW YE, That We, of Our special grace, certain knowledge, and mere motion, have given and granted, and We do, by these Presents, for Us, Our Heirs and Successors, give and grant unto

Paul Wedge his

Heirs and Assigns,

a Tract of Land situate in the Parish of *Acadiville*

in the County of *New*

in Our Province

of New Brunswick, and bounded as follows, to-wit:—

Beginning at a Maple tree standing on the northern side of the Acadiville Settlement road at the south east angle of plot number one purchased by Robert Wilson in the Acadiville Settlement thence running by the Magnet north three degrees and thirty minutes east fifty chains thence south eighty six degrees and thirty minutes east twenty chains thence south three degrees and thirty minutes west fifty chains to a fir tree standing on the northern side of the Acadiville Settlement road aforesaid and thence along the same north eighty six degrees and thirty minutes west twenty chains to the place beginning containing one hundred acres more or less and distinguished as lot number two in the Acadiville Settlement

and also particularly described or marked on the Plot or Plan of Survey hereunto annexed; together with all profits, commodities, hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever thereunto belonging, or in any wise appertaining; except and reserved, nevertheless, out of this present Grant, to Us, Our Heirs and Successors, all Goals, and also all Gold and Silver, and other Mines and Minerals: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said *tract* of Land,
