KNOW YE, That We, of Our special grace, certain knowledge, and mere motion, have given and granted, and We do, by these Presents, for Us, Our Heirs and Successors, give and grant unto

Jeddie Vevean his

Heirs and Assigns,

a Tract of Land situate in the Parish of *Rogersville*

in the County of *Northumberland* in Our Province

of New Brunswick, and bounded as follows, to-wit:— *Beginning at a*

birch tree standing on the southern side
of a reserved road at the north west angle
of lot number One Hundred and twenty two
in Rogersville Settlement east thence running
by the magnet south sixty seven chains thence
west four chains thence north forty degrees
west seventeen chains thence north fifty
three chains and fifty links to a spruce tree
standing on the southern side of the afore
said reserved road and thence along the
same east fifteen chains to the place of beginning
Containing ninety three acres more or less and
distinguishe'd as lot number One Hundred
and twenty one in Rogersville Settlement East

and also particularly described or marked on the Plot, or Plan of Survey hereunto annexed; together with all profits, commodities, hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever thereunto belonging, or in any wise appertaining; except and reserved, nevertheless, out of this present Grant, to Us, Our Heirs and Successors, all Coals, and also all Gold and Silver, and other Mines and Minerals: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said *tract* of Land, and all and singular the Premises hereby granted, with their appurtenances, (except before excepted) unto the said *Jeddie Vevean his* Heirs and Assigns, FOR EVER. PROVIDED ALWAYS, and this present Grant is upon condition, that the same Grant be registered in the Secretary's Office of Our said Province of New Brunswick, to which Registry shall be attached a Duplicate of the Plan hereunto annexed.
