KNOW YE, That We, of Our special grace, certain knowledge, and mere motion, have given and

granted, and We do, by these Presents, for Us, Our Heirs and Successors, give and grant unto

Urbane Daigle his Heirs and Assigns,

a Tract of Land situate in the Parish of Acaderville

in the County of Kent

in Our Province

of New Brunswick, and bounded as follows:—Beginning at a

beach tree standing on the southern side of the Acaderville road at the north east angle of lot number ninety three granted to Silvain Barault in Acaderville Settlement thence running by the magnet south three degrees and thirty minutes west sixty seven chains to the northern bank or shore of Touchabouague River thence along the same following the several courses thereof down stream in an easterly direction with a rectangular distance of fourteen chains and twenty five links thence north three degrees and thirty minutes east to sixty six chains to a first tree standing on the southern side of the Acaderville road aforesaid and thence along the same north eighty six degrees and thirty minutes west fourteen chains and twenty five links to the place of beginning containing ninety five acres more or less and distinguished as lot number ninety two in the Acaderville Settlement

and also particularly described or marked on the Plot or Plan of Survey hereunto annexed; together with all profits, commodities, hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever thereunto belonging, or in any wise appertaining; except and reserved, nevertheless, out of this present Grant, to Us, Our Heirs and Successors, all Coals, and also all Gold and Silver, and other Mines and Minerals: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract of Land,

and all and singular the Premises hereby granted, with their appurtenances, (except before excepted) unto the said

Urbane Daigle his

Heirs and Assigns, FOR EVER.
