QUEEN, Defender of the Faith, &c. To all to whom these Presents shall come, Greeting:

KNOW YE, That We, of Our special grace, certain knowledge, and mere motion, have given and granted, and We do, by these Presents, for Us, Our Heirs and Successors, give and grant unto

Peter Veno his Heirs and Assigns,

a Tract of Land situate in the Parish of *Rogerville*,
in the County of *Northumberland* in Our Province
of New Brunswick, and bounded as follows, to-wit:—

*Beginning at a
Spruce tree standing on the north western
side of a reserved road at the most eastern
angle of lot number seven purchased by
John O'Beare in Rogerville Settlement
thence running by the magnet north forty
degrees west sixty seven Chains thence north
fifty degrees east fifteen Chains to a spruce tree
thence south forty degrees east sixty seven chains
to a buck tree standing on the north western
side of the aforesaid reserved road and thence
along the same south fifty degrees west fifteen
Chains to the place of beginning. Containing
One Hundred Acres more or less and distin-
guished as lot number eight in Rogerville
Settlement*

and also particularly described or marked on the Plot or Plan of Survey hereunto annexed; together with all profits, commodities, hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever thereunto belonging, or in any wise appertaining: except and reserved, nevertheless, out of this present Grant, to Us, Our Heirs and Successors, all Coals, and also all Gold and Silver, and other Mines and Minerals: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said *Tract* of Land, and all and singular the Premises hereby granted, with their appurtenances, (except before excepted) unto the said *Peter Veno* Heirs and Assigns, for ever, PROVIDED ALWAYS, and this present Grant is upon condition, that the same Grant be registered in the Secretary's Office of Our said Province of New Brunswick, to which Registry shall be attached a Duplicate of the Plan hereunto annexed.
