KNOW YE, That We, of Our special grace, certain knowledge, and mere motion, have given and granted, and We do, by these Presents, for Us, Our Heirs and Successors, give and grant unto

*Marshall Gould his*

Heirs and Assigns,

a Tract of Land situate in the Parish of

*Acadewille*

in the County of

*Hent*

in Our Province

of New Brunswick, and bounded as follows, to-wit:—

*Beginning at a  
Cucumber tree standing on the southern side  
of the Acadewille Road at the northwest angle  
of lot number ninety eight in the Acadewille  
Settlement. thence running by the magnet south  
three degrees and thirty minutes west fifty seven  
Chains to the northern bank or shore of the Kouchi-  
bougauc River thence along the same following  
the several courses there up stream in a  
westerly direction, with a rectangular distance  
of sixteen Chains thence north three degrees and  
thirty minutes east sixty one Chains to a Cucumber  
tree standing on the southern side of the Acadewille  
Road aforesaid, and thence along the same  
south eighty six degrees and thirty minutes east  
sixteen Chains to the place of beginning, Contain-  
ing ninety acres more or less and distinguished  
as lot number ninety nine in Acadewille Settle-  
ment.*
