Victoria, by the Grace of GOD, of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland,  
QUEEN, Defender of the Faith, &c. To all to whom these Presents shall come, Greeting:

KNOW YE, That We, of Our special grace, certain knowledge, and mere motion, have given and granted, and We do, by these Presents, for Us, Our Heirs and Successors, give and grant unto

*Absalom Ruston his* Heirs and Assigns,

a Tract of Land situate in the Parish of *Acadewille*  
in the County of *West* in Our Province

of New Brunswick, and bounded as follows, to-wit:—

*Beginning at a Maple and stake standing on the northern bank or shore of Kouchibougué River at the south east angle of lot number one hundred and five granted to M. McEwen on the eastern side of the Intercolonial Railway thence running by the Magnet north three degrees and thirty minutes east eighty one Chains to a stake, thence north eighty six degrees and twenty minutes west thirty two Chains to a spruce tree standing on the eastern side of a reserved road on the easterly side of and adjoining the Intercolonial Railway and reserve line aforesaid thence along the same north seven degrees and twenty minutes west seven Chains and fifty links to the southern side of the Acadewille road thence along the same south eighty six degrees and twenty minutes east forty four Chains to a spruce tree thence south three degrees and thirty minutes west ninety three Chains to the northern bank or shore of the Kouchibougué River aforesaid, and thence along the*

*same following the several courses thereof up stream in a westerly direction to the place of beginning, containing one hundred and twenty eight acres more or less and distinguished as lot number one hundred and fifteen in the Acadewille Settlement*

and also particularly described or marked on the Plot or Plan of Survey hereunto annexed; together with all profits, commodities, hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever thereunto belonging, or in any wise appertaining; except and reserved, nevertheless, out of this present Grant, to Us, Our Heirs and Successors, all Coals, and also all Gold and Silver, and other Mines and Minerals: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said *tract* of Land, and all and singular the Premises hereby granted, with their appurtenances, (except before excepted) unto the said

*Absalom Ruston his* Heirs and Assigns, FOR EVER.

PROVIDED ALWAYS, and this present Grant is upon condition, that the same Grant be registered in the Secretary's Office of Our said Province of New Brunswick, to which Registry shall be attached a Duplicate of the Plan hereunto annexed.
