Victoria, by the Grace of GOD, of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland,
QUEEN, Defender of the Faith, &c. To all to whom these Presents shall come, Greeting:

KNOW YE, That We, of Our special grace, certain knowledge, and mere motion, have given and granted, and We do, by these Presents, for Us, Our Heirs and Successors, give and grant unto

John Doiron his Heirs and Assigns,
a Tract of Land situate in the Parish of *Acadiville*
in the County of *Kent* in Our Province
of New Brunswick, and bounded as follows, to-wit:—

*Beginning at a
fir tree standing on the northern side
of a reserved road at the south east angle
of lot number four purchased by Alexandre
Ballant in the Acadiville Settlement thence
running by the magnet north three degrees
and thirty minutes east eighty chains thence
south eighty six degrees and thirty minutes east
twelve chains and fifty links thence south
three degrees and thirty minutes west eighty
chains to another fir tree standing on the
northern side of the aforesaid reserved
road and thence along the same north eighty
six degrees and thirty minutes west twelve
chains and fifty links to the place of beginning,
containing One Hundred acres more or less
and distinguished as lot number five in the
Acadiville Settlement*

and also particularly described or marked on the Plot or Plan of Survey hereunto annexed; together with all profits, commodities, hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever thereunto belonging, or in any wise appertaining; except and reserved, nevertheless, out of this present Grant, to Us, Our Heirs and Successors, all Coals, and also all Gold and Silver, and other Mines and Minerals: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said *tract* of Land,

and all and singular the Premises hereby granted, with their appurtenances, (except before excepted) unto the said *John Doiron his* Heirs and Assigns, FOR EVER.

PROVIDED ALWAYS, and this present Grant is upon condition, that the same Grant be registered in the Secretary's Office of Our said Province of New Brunswick, to which Registry shall be attached a Duplicate of the Plan hereunto annexed.
