Victoria, by the Grace of GOD, of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland,
QUEEN, Defender of the Faith, &c To all to whom these Presents shall come, Greeting:

KNOW YE, That We, of Our special grace, certain knowledge, and mere motion, have given and granted, and We do, by these Presents, for Us, Our Heirs and Successors, give and grant unto

Thomas A. Buckley his Heirs and Assigns,
a Tract of Land situate in the Parish of *Rogerville*
in the County of *Northumberland* in Our Province
of New Brunswick, and bounded as follows, to-wit:—

Beginning at a maple tree standing on the western side of the Intercolonial Railway and reservation at the north east angle of lot number fifteen granted to Germaine Heblaine in Barnaby River Settlement three running by the Magnet South eighty nine degrees West fifty Chains three north seven degrees and thirty minutes West with a rectangular distance of twenty Chains three north eighty nine degrees east fifty Chains to a hemlock tree standing on the western side of the aforesaid Intercolonial Railway and reservation and thence along the same South seven degrees and thirty minutes east with a rectangular distance of twenty Chains to the place of beginning Containing one Hundred acres more or less and distinguished as lot number fourteen in the Barnaby River Settlement

and also particularly described or marked on the Plot or Plan of Survey hereunto annexed; together with all profits, commodities, hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever thereunto belonging, or in any wise appertaining; except and reserved, nevertheless, out of this present Grant, to Us, Our Heirs and Successors, all Coals, and also all Gold and Silver, and other Mines and Minerals: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said *tract* of Land, and all and singular the Premises hereby granted, with their appurtenances, (except before excepted) unto the said *Thomas A. Buckley* his Heirs and Assigns, FOR EVER.
PROVIDED ALWAYS, and this present Grant is upon condition, that the same Grant be registered in the Secretary's Office of Our said Province of New Brunswick, to which Registry shall be attached a Duplicate of the Plan hereunto annexed.
