**Victoria**, by the Grace of GOD, of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland,  
QUEEN, Defender of the Faith, &c To all to whom these Presents shall come, *Greeting:*

KNOW YE, That We, of Our special grace, certain knowledge, and mere motion, have given and granted, and We do, by these Presents, for Us, Our Heirs and Successors, give and grant unto

*Sebastian Legere* his Heirs and Assigns,  
a Tract of Land situate in the Parish of *Acadewille*  
in the County of *Kent* in Our Province

of New Brunswick, and bounded as follows, to-wit:—

*Beginning at a stake standing in the southern side of a reserved road at the north east angle of lot number one hundred and six purchased by George M Wood in the Acadewille Settlement, thence running by the Magnet along the said reserved road south eighty six degrees and thirty minutes east fifteen Chains to a fir tree thence south three degrees and thirty minutes west sixty six Chains to the northern bank or shore of Roachebougal River, thence along the same following the several Courses thereof, up stream in a westerly direction, with a rectangular distance of fifteen Chains and thence north three degrees and thirty minutes east sixty six Chains to the place of beginning containing unity five acres more or less and distinguished as lot number one hundred and five in the Acadewille Settlement.*

\*and also particularly described or marked on the Plot or Plan of Survey hereunto annexed; together with all profits, commodities, hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever thereunto belonging, or in any wise appertaining; except and reserved, nevertheless, out of this present Grant, to Us, Our Heirs and Successors, all Coals, and also all Gold and Silver, and other Mines and Minerals: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said *tract* of Land, and all and singular the Premises hereby granted, with their appurtenances, (except before excepted) unto the said *Sebastian Legere* his Heirs and Assigns, FOR EVER. PROVIDED ALWAYS, and this present Grant is upon condition, that the same Grant be registered in the Secretary's Office of Our said Province of New Brunswick, to which Registry shall be attached a Duplicate of the Plan hereunto annexed.

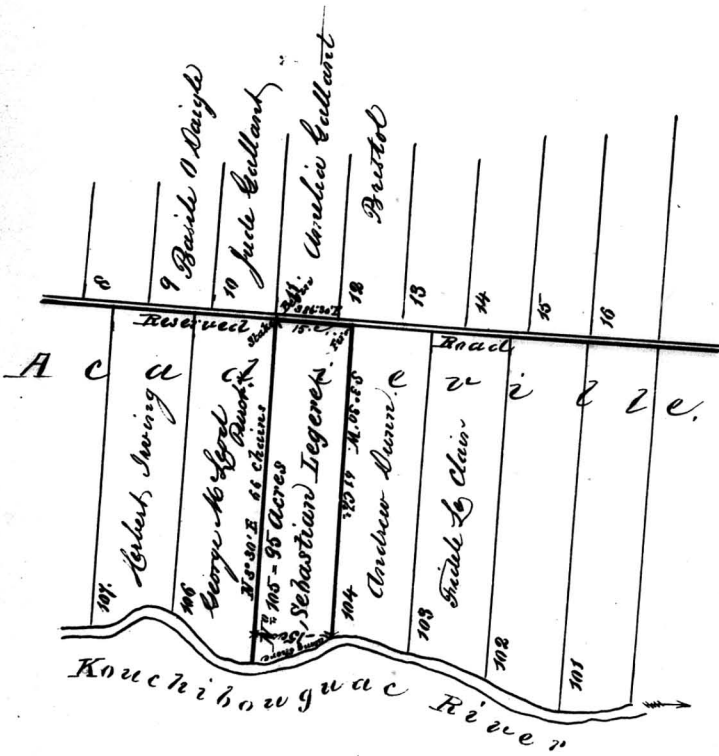
