P. O. O'Brien **Victoria**, by the Grace of GOD, of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland,
QUEEN, Defender of the Faith, &c To all to whom these Presents shall come, *Greeting* :

KNOW YE, That We, of Our special grace, certain knowledge, and mere motion, have given and granted, and We do, by these Presents, for Us, Our Heirs and Successors, give and grant unto

Ambrose Belliveau his Heirs and Assigns,
a Tract of Land situate in the Parish of *Headville*
in the County of *Kent*

in Our Province

of New Brunswick, and bounded as follows, to-wit:—

Beginning at a hickory tree standing on the northern ^{side} of a reserved road at the southeast angle of Lot number seventy five purchased by Val Richard on the southern side of Rouchibouqua River and east of the ~~great~~ Intercolonial Railway; thence running by the Magnet North three degrees and fifteen minutes east fifty three chains to the southern Bank or shore of the aforesaid Rouchibouqua River; thence along the same in an easterly direction following the various courses thereof downstream with a rectilinear distance of eighteen chains and fifty links; thence ~~with~~ three degrees and fifteen minutes West, fifty eight chains to a stake standing on the northern side of the aforesaid reserved road and thence along the same North eighty six degrees and forty five minutes West, eighteen and fifty links to the place of beginning.

Containing one hundred acres more or less and distinguished as Lot number seventy four on the southern side of Rouchibouqua River and east of the Intercolonial Railway

and also particularly described or marked on the Plot or Plan of Survey hereunto annexed; together with all profits, commodities, hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever thereunto belonging, or in any wise appertaining; except and reserved, nevertheless, out of this present Grant, to Us, Our Heirs and Successors, all Coals, and also all Gold and Silver, and other Mines and Minerals: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said *tract* of Land, and all and singular the Premises hereby granted, with their appurtenances, (except before excepted) unto the said

Ambrose Belliveau his Heirs and Assigns, FOR EVER.

PROVIDED ALWAYS, and this present Grant is upon condition, that the same Grant be registered in the Secretary's Office of Our said Province of New Brunswick, to which Registry shall be attached a Duplicate of the Plan hereunto annexed.
